

General Car Line Procedures at the Golden Campus: 2020-2021 Compass Montessori Golden

Drop-Off

Students are to arrive within the Drop-Off window each morning, and not before. If students arrive after their drop-off window they must go directly to the exterior door of the classroom to check-in and the teacher will notify the front office of their arrival.

- 8:00 - 8:30 for High School
- 8:00 - 8:30 for Farm School
- 8:00 - 8:30 for Elementary
- 8:15 - 8:45 for Children's House (Car Line)

Please Note: Only staff should use the North Parking Lot by the High School. High school students should park in the main lot.

When dropping your child off, please pull all the way forward around the Circle along the sidewalk so we minimize the congestion on Salvia Street, and keep the carline moving along.

Elementary and Secondary students can get out of the car in a safe location and walk directly to their classrooms' exterior entrances; only children's house students need to be screened and checked during the carline procedure.

As the safety of your child(ren) is our highest priority, do not stop mid-way around the circle or pull in front of other cars. We will have staff outside on the curb to support your child(ren) safely getting to class.

If you are unloading a bike please park in the South Lot so as to not hold up the flow of traffic through the Circle.

Pick-Up

Parents with multiple children attending our Children's House, Elementary, Farm School and/or High School programs are to arrive at pick-up within the latest window for their children's programs:

- 2:45 - 3:00 for Elementary and High School
- 3:00 - 3:15 for Children's House
- 3:00 - 3:15 for Farm School

All children with siblings will join those siblings in carline during the pick-up window of the youngest child in the family. Due to state licensing requirements, parents and guardians of Children's House students will need to pull through the carline, wait for their child to be escorted down from the classroom, and sign their child out for the day. If you have multiple children to buckle, please pull through the carline and park to buckle them in.

Please do not arrive and wait in the Circle more than 5 minutes ahead of your child being released from school. If you must arrive earlier, please park in the North or South Lot and wait there until your child(ren)'s dismissal window.

When picking-up, please pull all the way forward around the Circle along the sidewalk so we minimize the congestion on Salvia Street, and keep the carline moving along. As the safety of your child(ren) is our highest priority, do not stop mid-way around the circle or pull in front of other cars. We will have staff outside on the curb to support your children safely getting into the appropriate vehicles.

If you are loading a bike, please park in the South Lot so as to not hold up the flow of traffic through the Circle.

All secondary students must be picked up by the end of their pick-up window:


- ❑ 3:00 for High School (unless the student is a sibling of a student who dismisses from Compass after 3 pm)
- ❑ 3:15 for Farm School After school, teachers are responsible for team meetings and planning and are therefore not able to supervise students.

Due to safety concerns, all secondary students must leave the Golden campus at these scheduled times - unless prior arrangements have been made with guides, advisors, and/or program directors for school-sponsored opportunities or for school-related work.

Drop-Off

Students are to arrive within the Drop-Off window each morning, and not before. If students arrive after their drop-off window they must go directly to the exterior door of the classroom to check-in and the teacher will notify the front office of their arrival.

- ❑ 8:00 - 8:30 for Elementary
- ❑ 8:15 - 8:45 for Children's House (Car Line)

Children's House: When dropping your child off, please only the main lot circle to drop your child off to be screened efficiently.

Elementary: You are welcome to drop your child off in either the main lot or side hug and go pull-through.

Please pull all the way forward to best minimize the congestion on 44th/Miller Street and keep the carline moving along.

Elementary students can get out of the car at the main school doors in the main lot and in a safe sidewalk location in the hug and go. They can then walk directly to their classrooms' exterior entrances; only children's house students need to be screened and checked during the carline procedure.

As the safety of your child(ren) is our highest priority, do not stop mid-way around the circle or pull in front of other cars. We will have staff outside on the curb to support your child(ren) safely getting to class.

- ❑ 2:45 - 3:00 for Elementary
- ❑ 3:00 - 3:15 for Children's House
